L: Like the disciples walking the road to Emmaus, we are in need of your company!


All: Jesus, stand among us, in your risen power, let this time of worship, be a hallowed hour.


Gloria Dei are also working towards these efforts. How wonderful for us all to be able to help our neighbors!

Grace Family,




